### "HOW MUCH IS TOO MUCH?"

We live in an era of abundances and excesses. We have TOO MUCH. Our every waking moment is bombarded bv vendors who seek to create a desire for "MORE." Charities, Churches, and Missions plead with us to give MORE. And we just never get enough money to buy the things we "need" nor to help meet the "needs" of others. In desperation and frustration we cry. "It is *Too Much*?" I'm sure all of us have "spent too Much," have "Paid too Much." but how many of us have really "GIVEN Too Much?" "HOW MUCH IS TOO MUCH?"

People sometimes think that it costs too much to carry on the Lord's work and so they recommend that the church and missions retrench, that the preacher's salary be cut, that missionaries or fields be dropped from the roll. They selfishly lose sight of the fact that "We are Ambassadors for Christ", that "We are not our own, that we are bought with a price" and are therefore to "glorify God in our body, and in our spirit, which are God's." (I Cor. 6:19, 20) And that "God has committed unto us the ministry of reconciliation" - something which God has placed before us as a MEANS OF OUR BLESSING! So we can be blessed only as we GIVE Him back a portion of that which He has given to us. We can only have the blessing of God as we come to know something of the JOY OF SACRI-FICE. The idea of "cost-cutting" comes from a LACK OF LOVE for the Lord Jesus Christ. A person who LOVES, never thinks of the cost.

WE HAVE ENOUGH TIME AND MONEY FOR THE THINGS WE LOVE! The consumption of liquor, cigarettes, gourmet foods and luxury items of all kinds are at an all-time high. Spending for vacations, automobiles, boats, etc. is seemingly limitless. But church giving is not keeping pace! HUMANITY IS IN THE RED - Personal income is at a record high in the U.S., but gifts to churches and benevolences are down. It has been said that there are THREE KINDS OF GIVERS IN THE WORLD: "The Flint Giver"-Where you have to hammer and hammer to get a little spark out of the person:

"The Sponge Giver"—He will give a little if squeezed hard enough. "The Honey Giver" — He gives as a bee gives — naturally, and exudes sweetness.

Let us note God's order in His Word: God's people are exhorted and commanded to give *proportionately* of their income. When God asks something of His people. He does *not* ask TOO MUCH! As we come to the Word, we find God's immutable laws are for proportionate giving from THE BEGINNING:

1. ADAM AND EVE (Gen. 2:16, 17) — God teaches the first man that a PORTION of the Garden belonged to God and that man could have all the rest. But that ONE THING belonged to God, and man could not pluck of it without bringing judgment upon himself.

2. CAIN AND ABEL (Gen. 4:3, 4) — God teaches that a PORTION of the flock belonged unto Him. Both men *understood* that an offering BE-LONGED to the Lord!

3. ABRAHAM (Gen. 14:18-20) — Five hundred years BEFORE the "Law" was given, Abram gave a tenth of all he had obtained to Melchizedek, Priest of the Most High God, who was typical of the Lord Jesus Christ.

4. JACOB (Gen. 28:20-22) — fled home, was friendless and penniless and now he says: "God, if you will feed me and clothe me and keep the wild animals from me and preserve me and bless me and bring me back to my father's house, Lord, I will give you a tenth." We smile at this, but remember — "God blessed this man because he KEPT HIS WORD!" You say: "Didn't God give it all to Jacob? He could well afford it." But, what have YOU today that you did not receive from God?

5. MOSES (Lev. 27:30) — The law of the Tithe was incorporated into the Law given by God to Moses on the Mount.

6. THE ISRAELITES (II Chron. 31:5) — Tithed in abundance ALL THINGS. (Mal. 3:8-10) They were exhorted to prove God's promises by practicing tithing. HE did not ask TOO MUCH!

7. THE LORD JESUS CHRIST (Luke 11:42) — commanded the law of tithes. Men should have tithed, He taught, but along with their tithing they should also have loved and have had judgment that was right in the sight of God. Much of the teaching of Christ had to do with the matter of giving. He Himself PRACTICED TITHING!

8. PAUL (I Cor. 16:1, 2) - believed in **PROPORTIONATE** GIV-ING. He steps out of the realm of the tithe and does not say it should be one-tenth because he evidently felt that was NOT ENOUGH under GRACE! In I Cor. 15:58 Paul writes those transcendent truths, speaking of the coming of the Lord and resurrection and how the church is to go on, "Always abounding in the work of the Lord." Then in I Cor. 16 he writes: "Now concerning the COL-LECTION." What is in mind here? As the resurrection has been brought about for our deliverance, so also the collection can be used to blessing the hearts of God's people and to bring blessing to the heart of God. IN OTHER WORDS: "Silver and Gold fit in very nicely with a message of resurrection." But most people say: "Let that go. I want to think about the Resurrection and the time when this mortal shall put on immortality, but I do not care to hear about the collection." THE TITHE IS NOT A GIFT, BUT INTEREST ON A DEBT! If you bought some Bonds at interest and were told by the seller: "We like you. We are going to give you something. We had a meeting and decided to give you this interest check." You would say: "Listen, you are not giving me anything, this is the interest on what you OWE me." SO WITH GOD! Many people think of the tithe as being a GIFT to God. But the tithe is simply INTEREST ON THAT WHICH GOD HAS PLACED IN YOUR HANDS FOR YOUR USE! One tenth BELONGS to God and whatever is given after

### Philippians 4

**CONTEXT:** Phil. 3:20,21 - "For our conversation (citizenship) is in heaven from whence also we look for the Saviour, the Lord Jesus Christ: Who shall change our vile body, that it may be fashioned like unto his glorious body, according to the working whereby he is able even to subdue all things unto himself."

In the light of these tremendous truths, the Apostle Paul writes:

#### Phil. 4:1 - THEREFORE, my brethren:

- A. STAND FAST IN THE LORD (4:1) Christ is the center of the believer's life. Being IN CHRIST is not only a POSITION but likewise a CONDITION a Divine Enablement.
  - B. BE OF THE SAME MIND IN THE LORD (4:2) Not necessarily to see everything eye to eye that would become monotonous. If we are not of the same mind in the Lord, then we are not enjoying fellowship with the Lord because we cannot be intimate with the Lord if we are estranged one from another. If there is a gap between the lives of believers, they can not be intimate with the Lord until that gap is closed up.
    - C. REJOICE IN THE LORD ALWAY (4:4) Some can rejoice sometimes in some things, but how many can rejoice always in all things? Neh. 8:10 - If you are not happy in the Lord, you have no strength!
      - 1. LET YOUR GENTLENESS BE KNOWN UNTO ALL MEN (4:5) A condition of BEING. An OUTWARD manifestation. "The Lord is at hand to help."
        - 2. LET YOUR REQUESTS BE MADE KNOWN UNTO GOD (4:6) "By prayer and supplication with thanksgiving. Being anxious for nothing." An INWARD grace. A state of DOING.

#### 1st PROMISE - (4:7) And THE PEACE OF GOD shall keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.

Note - The above five points give instructions for the obedience of every believer. The Peace of God shall keep the hearts and minds of only those who practice these things. Now, if the writer, the Apostle Paul, does not practice what he preaches, he is a hypocrite. In the following verses (8-19) Paul specifically testifies to having personally kept each command and boldly exhorts his hearers to "follow me, as I follow Christ." This outline is an 'inversion' - the following points being given in the 'inverse' order of those above.

#### Phil. 4:8 - FINALLY, brethren,

- THINK ON WHATSOEVER THINGS ARE: (4:8) True, honest, just, pure, lovely, and of good report. "As a man thinketh in his heart, so is he." A condition of BEING. An INWARD grace.
- DO THOSE THINGS WHICH YE HAVE BOTH: (4:9) learned and received and heard and seen in me. "Be ye imitators of me, as I am of Christ." (1 Cor. 11:1) A state of DOING. An OUTWARD manifestation.
- 2nd PROMISE (4:9) And THE GOD OF PEACE shall be with you. A development from the 1st Promise not just something (peace) eminating of or from God, but the very "God of Peace" Himself!

C. I REJOICED IN THE LORD GREATLY - (4:10)

- B. | HAVE LEARNED, (OF THE SAME MIND) in whatsoever state | am, therewith to be content. (4:11)
- A. I KNOW BOTH HOW TO BE ABASED (tested with adversity) and how to abound (tested with prosperity) (4:12) everywhere and in all things - to STAND FAST IN THE LORD! I am instructed both to be full and to be hungrey, both to abound and to suffer need.

Phil. 4:13 - THEREFORE - "Because I rejoiced in the Lord, because I have learned in whatsoever state I am to be content, because I have been tried and not found wanting in both adversity and prosperity-I can do all things through Christ who strengtheneth me!" The climactic lesson learned from the preceding! And unless we can testify to having successfully passed through steps C, B, and A, we cannot give this testimony.

3rd PROMISE - (4:19) MY GOD SHALL SUPPLY ALL YOUR NEED ACCORDING TO HIS RICHES IN GLORY IN CHRIST JESUS! Note a further development - not just THE GOD, but MY GOD, who hath wrought such miracles and accomplished such mighty things in and through me, Paul, shall also supply all YOUR NEED, even as He has mine.



(Eph. 2:2,3)	<b>BEFORE THE FALL</b> , when Adam walked in the garden, the spirit dom- inated his soul, i.e. intellect, emo- tions, will - and through the vessel of the 'soul' shone out in and through the earthly tabernacle of clay - the body - making it luminous with 'ight, impervious to cold & heat, and able to perfectly fulfil the object of its cre- ation. The order of our being from GOD'S point of view, is SPIRIT, SOUL, & BODY, because God's influence commences in the spirit, then lays hold of the emotions and the intellect of the soul, and lastly begins to curb the body. From SATAN'S standpoint it is reversed. 'Earthy (body), Soulish, Demoniacal (spirit)' James 3:15. Because his influence enters by the clay-made body; then seizes upon the soul; and, whenever possible, gains entrance to the spirit.





# "Preaching Christ"

#### 1 CORINTHIANS 1:17-24

#### BY MAURICE HAMMOND

There are six different aspects of the Person and work of the Lord Jesus Christ clearly expressed and frequently mentioned in the Scriptures: His Death, Blood, Cross, Resurrection, Ascension, and His Name. The Holy Spirit most surely says what He means, and means what He says. Therefore it is very important for the Lord's people to discriminate between these words and terms, for there is much indiscriminate use of them. Confusion and misuse of these words very often leads to doctrinal error and means spirtual weakness and failure. It is important when we, as good soldiers of Jesus Christ, go into war to know what weapons we need, and to be able to intelligently choose and use those weapons. It is also very important for unsaved people to know the true meaning of these terms if they are to be saved.

### A Triune Partnership

The Lord Jesus Christ informed His disciples, "Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go and bring forth fruit." (John 15:16) He said of the Apostle Paul, "...he is a chosen vessel unto me." (Acts 9:15) To all believers in this dispensation He states: "He hath chosen us in him before the foundation of the world." (Eph. 1:4) "Now then we are ambassadors for Christ." (2 Cor. 5:20)

In God's providence He has limited Himself to man alone, as the exclusive instrumentality in the accomplishment of His purpose for this present dispensation. In former dispensations the Lord used Angel messengers. He will use them yet again after the Body of Christ is completed and raptured. During this present age, the heavens are *silent*, though God is most certainly not inactive, disinterested, nor powerless.

Lest we should become puffed up with this high calling, the Lord reminds us that, "not many wise men after the flesh, not many mighty, not many nobel, are called: but God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise; and God hath chosen the weak things of the world to confound the things which are mighty; and base things which are despised, hath God chosen, yea, and things which are not to bring to naught things that are: that no flesh should glory in his presence. (I Cor. 1:26-29) With such weak and beggardly vessels it should be obvious to man that "without Me ye can do nothing." (John 15:5) "For we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellency of the power may be of God, and not of us." (2 Cor. 4:7)

We then are nothing, have nothing, and can do nothing good apart from the Lord Jesus Christ. (Rom. 7:18-25) Man's power for good is limited to (and yet is as infinite as) God's. On the other hand, God's power is limited to (and is as finite as) man's will. For the yielded believer however, "It is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of His good pleasure." (Phil. 2:13)

Therefore, for the realization of God's will in this dispensation, (the completion and edification of the Body of *Christ*) God and man are MUTUALLY DEPENDENT, are MUTUALLY INDISPENSIBLE to each other. The believer is in effect involved in a PARTNERSHIP with the Godhead. He is said to be: a co-laborer together with God, a co-sufferer together with Christ, and a co-witness together with the Holy Spirit.

### I. A CO-LABORER TOGETHER WITH GOD (the Father) - 1 Cor. 3:9; 2 Cor. 6:1

The judgment of the believer is to be for his works to determine his rewards. (1 Cor. 3:8-15; Rom. 14:10; 2 Cor. 5:10) "The fire (God's judgment) shall try every man's

WORK of what sort it is." (1 Cor. 3:13) The believer's WORK (what he has accomplished, the fruit he has born) will be judged, not his knowledge, nor intentions. It is not a case of how much one knows of spiritual truths, but what has been done with what one does know. Also note that it is the QUALITY (of what sort it is) of the workmanship and not the QUANTITY which is to be judged.

Especially notice that the believer is to labor TO-GETHER WITH God - not to labor FOR God. The Lord does not give man an assignment and then leave him to his own devices to "do the best he can in his own weak way." But He has promised, "I will never leave thee nor forsake thee." So that we may say, "The Lord is my helper." (Heb. 13:5,6) From other passages we learn that God has a specific TIME, (1 Tim. 2:6; Tit. 1:3) a specific PLACE, (Acts 16:7-10) and a specific MINISTRY (Heb. 9:24-26) for each of His ambassadors - those whom He has CALLED (Rom. 8:28-31) and GIFTED (Eph. 4:7,11) for the service to be rendered.

Following the record of Christ's Commission to His apostles in Mark 16:14-20, we are told in vts. 20, "And they went forth, and preached every where, the Lord WORKING WITH them, and confirming the word with signs following." In the period of the Acts, during which time all of these signs were manifested, it was not so much The Acts of the Apostles, as The Acts of the Holy Spirit as God WORKED WITH and through His human instrumentalities.

The need for the Gospel is everywhere, but one man cannot work everywhere nor do everything. However, he can do something, somewhere if he appropriates the power of the risen, ascended, and triumphant Saviour. And if he allows God to lead him to that one place, at that one time when He is doing that one thing for which he was called and talented.

Inasmuch as every working of God will be challenged and opposed by Satan through the carnal men and demon spirits which he controls, everyone who becomes a *laborer together with God* will soon discover that he has also been called to become:

#### II. A CO-SUFFERER TOGETHER WITH CHRIST Col. 1:24; Phil. 1:28-30; 2 Cor. 6:1-10; Rom. 8:17,18, 28,29; 1 Pet. 4:12-16; 5:10

In Col. 1:24 the Apostle Paul testifies that he was rejoicing in his sufferings for the believers, by which he was filling up that which was behind or lacking of the afflictions of Christ. It was not only necessary that the Lord Jesus Christ should die, ("for the wages of sin is death," Rom. 6:23 and therefore God "hath made him to be sin for us, who knew no sin; that we might be made the righteousness of God in him." 2 Cor. 5:21) but also that he should suffer. (Heb. 2:10; 5:8; 13:12) Now inasmuch as "The servant is not greater than lord." (John 15:20) "Unto you it is given in the behalf Christ, not only to believe on him, but also to suffer for sake; having the same conflict which ye saw in me, and hear to be in me," (Phil. 1:29,30) says the Apostle al.

When we speak of suffering together with Christ we eak of that persecution. that estrangement from and retion by the world, that defamation of character, that huliation and mockery, which the good soldier of Jesus rist bears because he has come out from among them and separated unto God to reveal the Lord Jesus Christ to a wild controled by "the prince of the power of the air." ph. 2:2; 2 Cor. 4:4) We do not mean the suffering which Il accrue as the natural consequence of sin and disobeence to God.

The teaching that, all suffering is the result of sin, id if the believer would confess his sin to God the sufferig would be alleviated is one of the "doctrines of demons." ! Tim. 4:1) All sin will bear its natural fruit, "corrupion" (Gal. 6:7-9) which brings suffering and shame to the inner. But not all suffering is the consequence of unconessed sin. The disciples "departed from the presence of he council, rejoicing that they were counted worthy to sufer shame for his name." (Acts 5:41; 9:16) If you are a coaborer together with God," you will positively not escape peing a co-sufferer together with Christ!

#### III. A CO-WITNESS TOGETHER WITH THE HOLY SPIRIT - John 15:26,27; 2 Cor. 13:1; Rom. 8:16.

The Lord Jesus Christ informs His disciples, in the context of His speaking of the world's rejection of Him, (they hated me without a cause) that, "when the Comforter (the Holy Spirit) is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceedeth from the Father, he shall testify of me: AND'YE ALSO SHALL BEAR WITNESS, because ye have been with me from the beginning." (John 15:26,27)

The express purpose of sending the Holy Spirit into the world was to BEAR WITNESS OF CHRIST. The Holy Spirit will ever and only reveal and glorify the Lord Jesus Christ. "Hereby know ye the Spirit of God: Every Spirit that confesseth that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is of

God: and every spirit that confesseth not that Jesus Christ is come in the flesh is not of God: and this is that spirit of antichrist," (1 John 4:2,3) Every spirit that denies, or even fails to confess Christ is of Satan.

Now inasmuch as it is necessary to establish every word IN THE MOUTH OF TWO OR THREE WITNESSES, (2 Cor. 13:1) the Lord tells His disciples that "YE ALSO shall bear witness, because ye have been with me from the beginning." These twelve apostles bore witness to the children of Israel concerning their earthly kingdom hope. In this dispensation of Grace the members of the Body of Christ are to bear witness of Christ, TOGETHER WITH the Holy Spirit, concerning our heavenly hope. (Eph. 1:3) That hope of being "caught up together with them in the cloud, to meet the Lord in the air." (1 Thes. 4:13-17) Though our hope is different, salvation is the same, only through the Lord Jesus Christ and personal faith in Him.

In Rom. 8:16 we read, "The Spirit himself beareth witness WITH our spirit, (not TO our spirit) that we are the children of God." The Holy Spirit speaks to a man to reveal Christ, that is ONE witness. Then a believer also witnesses to that man concerning Christ - that is TWO wit nesses. In some cases there may be many many human wit. nesses, and many workings of the Holy Spirit before an in dividual surrenders to the Lord Jesus Christ. But in every case, no man is saved without BOTH witnesses (the Divine and the Human). "No man can come to me, except the Fath er which hath sent me draw him." (John 6:44) "And I, if be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me." (John 12:32) This is the Divine side. On the human side "we are ambassadors for Christ, as though God did beseec you BY US: we pray you in Christ's stead, be ye reconcile to God." (2 Cor. 5:20)

Perhaps you have tried to witness to someone and has no success. The Holy Spirit was just not present. Yet of another occasion you had great liberty and it was obvious the Lord was present and working in power. Even when seems that "nothing happens" we have the assurance that God's word "shall not return unto him void, but it shall and complish that which he pleases." (Isa. 55:11) Paul says "I have planted, Apollos watered; but God gave the in crease. So then neither is he that planteth any thing, neith er he that watereth; but God that giveth the increase." ( Cor. 3:6,7) May all glory and praise redound to His Hol

**THEY SHALL NOT RISE:** therefore hast Thou visited and destroyed them, and made all their memory to perish." (These REPHAIM will not rise. They were the progeny of the fallen angels: these latter are kept "in prison" - 1 Pet. 3:19, in "chains" - 2 Pet. 2:4; Jude 6, "reserved" unto judgment: but their progeny will "not rise" or be judged, for they have been "visited", "destroyed", and "perished". See Appendixes 23, 24, 25 of the Companion Bible, from which also these notes were taken.)

**GEN. 6:1-7** - THE GIANTS - the NEPHILIM (fallen ones) great in size and wickedness - superhuman, abnormal beings - the progeny of fallen angels.

**GEN.** 14:5 - A branch of the Nephilim, they are superhuman beings, so called after one Rapha: as the Anakim after Anak. See Gen. 15:18-21 where they are enumerated and named.

**NUM.** 13:33 - "And there we (the 10 spies) saw the giants (Nephilim) the sons of Anak, which come of the giants: and we were in our own sight as grasshippers, and so we were in their sight."

**DEUT.** 2:10-11 - "THE EMIMS (*Terrible ones, a race of the Nephilim*) dwelt therein in times past, a people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims; which also were accounted GIANTS, (*REPHAIM - connected with healing, and with Egypt*) as the Anakims, but the Moabites call them Emims."

**DEUT.** 2:20,21 - "That also was accounted a land of Giants; giants dwelt therein in old time; and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims (noisey ones.)

**DEUT.** 3:11,13 - Their strength is seen in the giant cities of Bashan, which are associated with Egypt and may explain the building of the pyramids. "(For only Og king of Bashan remained of the remnant of giants (*REPHAIM*) behold his bedstead (bed or couch, but not the usual word which is MISHKAB. It is 'ERES, and is exactly the same measurement as the tomb of Marduk in Babylon. Probably therefore - his tomb.) was a bedstead of iron; (probably basalt) is it not in Rabbath (the capital of Ammon, where the temple of Milchom was; and where Og's tomb would naturally be.) of the children of Ammon? Nine cubits was the length thereof, (about 14 ft.) and four cubits (6 ft.) the breadth of it, after the cubit of a man.)"

JOB 16:14 - "He breaketh me with breach upon breach, He runneth upon me like a giant." (mighty man. Heb. gibbor - heroes - "men of renown" - "men of the name" i.e. who got a name and were renowned for their ungodliness.)

#### THE OBJECT OF THE FLOOD

**GEN.** 6:1-9 - The destruction of these Giants was necessary for the preservation of the human race and for the faithfulness of God's Word.

The cohabitation of fallen angels (sons of God) with the daughters of Adam was Satan's first attempt to prevent the coming of the "Seed of the woman" foretold in Gen. 3:15. If this could be accomplished, God's Word would have failed, and his own doom would be averted.

Note that the "Seed" was of the woman, not the man, as in natural generation, therefore the purpose was to contaminate her seed (later we see the attack directed upon Sarah, Gen. 12:10-20; 20:1-18, when God reveals that it is through her that the seed, "Isaac" was to come.

Only Noah and his family had preserved their pedigree pure from Adam - Gen. 6:9 - "Noah was a just man and perfect (without blemish as to breed or pedigree, not moral perfection) in his generations (contemporaries). All the rest had become "corrupt." The only remedy was to destroy these Nephilim and the human family which had become contaminated. The seed must be pure, not part human and part superhuman. The Nephilim were of abnormal size and character, monsters of iniquity, and had to be destroyed. This was why the Flood was brought "upon the world of the ungodly (2 Pet. 2:5) as prophesied by Enoch (Jude 14).

But we read of the Nephilim again after the Flood. How could this be? The answer is in Gen. 6:4 - "There were Nephilim in the earth in those days (of Noah); and also AFTER THAT." So after the Flood, there was a second irruption of these fallen angels, evidently smaller in number and more limited in area, for their progeny were confined to Canaan, and were known as "the nations of Canaan." It was for the destruction of these that the sword of Israel was necessary, as the Flood had been before.

Soon after it became known that the seed was to come through Abraham and Sarah, Satan tried to prevent their entering the promised land, for when he came out from Haran (Gen. 12:6) and entered Canaan, "The Canaanite was then (*already*) in the land." And in Gen. 14:5 they were already known as "Rephaim" and "Emim."

#### **REPHAIM** rendered **DEAD** seven times:

#### (1) ISA. 26:19 - (considered above)

(2) JOB 26:5 - "Dead things (the Rephaim) are formed (remain) from under the waters, and the inhabitants thereof." (The Ellipsis must be supplied thus. "The place where the Rephaim stay is beneath the waters, and the things that are therein." This place is thus contrasted with the other place, Sheol, in the next verse.)

Thus the Rephaim, who were destroyed by the Flood, remain "under the waters," and are not in Sheol which is the "place of the dead" or abode of the disembodied souls of men.

(3) PSA. 88:10 - "Wilt Thou shew wonders to the dead (*Rephaim*)? Shall the dead (*Rephaim*, who have no resurrection) arise and praise Thee?"

(4) **PROV.** 2:16-22 - In this passage, the STRANGE WO-MAN, who is contrasted with Wisdom (*Christ*) is a prostitute priestess of Idolatrous religion. She is a stranger, therefore a foreigner (*Canaanite*) who has forsaken the guide of her youth, and forgotten the covenant of her God. v. 18 - "For her house inclineth unto death, and her paths unto the dead (*Rephaim*).

v. 19 - "None that go unto her RETURN AGAIN....." v. 22 - "But the wicked (*lawless*) shall be CUT OFF from the earth, and the transgressor shall be ROOTED OUT."

(5) **PROV. 9:18** - In the context (beginning with v. 1) a FOOLISH WOMAN (priestess prostitute) is contrasted with Wisdom (Christ). She sits at the door of her house in the high places of the city (Idol temples) to call to those who pass on their way. "But he (who passes) knoweth not that the dead (Rephaim) are there; And that her guests are in the depths of hell (Shcol).

(6) **PROV. 21:15,16**. "Destruction shall be to the workers of iniquity (*idolatry*). The man (*adam*) that wandereth out of the way of understanding shall remain in the congregation (*assembly*) of the dead (*Rephaim*)."

(7) ISA. 14:9 - "Hell (Sheol) from beneath is moved for thee to meet thec (Lucifer, King of Babylon) at thy coming: it stirreth up the dead (Rephaim) for thee...."

Note how the Rephaim are associated with Satan and his religions with all their idolatrous and immoral practices.






\* "TO DWELL" is the word "placed" in Gen. 3:24 which is the Hebrew word "shakan," meaning "to station" or "dwell in a tabernacle," from which the word "shekinah" (God's dwelling place among men) is derived. (Ex. 40:34,35; Lev. 16:2; 2 Sam. 6:2; 1 Kings 8:10,11) God has dwelt, or will dwell, in the midst of His people (both heavenly and earthly) in a succession of

eight tabernacles. The first and the eighth is the TRUE TABERNACLE in the heavens after which the Tabernacle in the Wilderness was patterned. (Heb. 8:2; 9:11,24) Note - God's House is ONE Tabernacle which is always a trinity of three parts or compartments, even as the Lord Himself is ONE GOD manifested in three Persons, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit.

• With the beginning of the dispensation of Grace and the formation of the Mystical Body of Christ, all believers are obliged to "Walk worthy" - a *superhuman* manner of life is proposed. (Eph. 4:1) A *supernatural power* is provided in the indwelling Holy Spirit. (Eph. 5:18) The standard of conduct perscribed is immeasurably more difficult to maintain than that perscribed by

either the law of Moses or the law of the kingdom. (Higher as heaven is higher than the earth.) Grace teachings are addressed only to the *supernaturally* endowed man, who is 'born of the Spirit' and 'Indwelt by the Spirit.' These teachings belong to 'citizens of heaven' - and the *walk* should become such citizens!



### The Seven Mysteries of the Millennium

#### MATTHEW 13

Old Testament prophecies contained many descriptions of the reign of Christ upon this earth - the main outlines were well known to the prophets and righteous men of old.

But in Matthew 13 we find the Lord speaking seven parables of that Kingdom. When asked why He speaks in parables, He answers; "Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven...for whosoever hath (the old things of the Old Testament prophecies) to him shall be given (the new things or mysteries of the kingdom of heaven). Matt. 13:10-13

Many had desired to see and hear these mysteries of the Kingdom, but they had remained SECRET until the Lord Jesus Christ uttered these seven parables.(13:17)

Isaiah fortells that in that kingdom the Word shall go forth from Jerusalem until the earth shall be full of the knowledge of the Lord as the waters cover the sea. Isa. 2:2-3; 11:9

#### THE SEVEN PARABLES

(1) "But, let me tell you a secret," saith the Lord, in THE PARABLE OF THE SOWER. "All of this seed will not grow, nor all that does grow will become fruitful." Matt. 13:3-23

Many a righteous man wondered as he pondered over the 38th and 39th chapters of Ezekiel, saying to himself, "Yes, I understand this FIRST uprising of Gog & Magog against Israel. (Ezek. 38:1-7; 39:1-29) Zechariah 14 speaks of that time, telling us that the Lord will come to the Mt. of Olives just in time to save us. We shall overcome our enemies and give their flesh to the birds, and it will take us seven months to bury the bones (Ezek. 39:12,13) and it will be a great renown to us. But what about this SECOND VISTATION IN THE LATTER YEARS? (Ezek. 38:8-23) When Gog comes AGAIN upon Israel AFTER she has been brought back from the sword, and is dwelling safely...without walls...bars or gates. How can such a thing as that happen?"

(2) "Listen to this mystery of the kingdom," saith the Lord in the PARABLE OF THE TARES - Matt. 13:24-30. Although all outwardly appears to be good in the kingdom, there will be tares growing secretly with the wheat. These are unbelievers at heart, who, though outwardly obliged to obey, will render but feigned obedience (Psa. 18:44; 66:3; 81:15) until at the end of the Millennium, when Satan is let loose, these tares will manifest themselves as such, and will gather themselves together in bands (Ezek. 38:22) against Israel (Ezek. 38:16) only to become bundles for the burning." Matt. 13:30; Rev. 20:9

(3) "Let me reveal still another secret," saith the Lord. "In the kingdom there will be A MUSTARD SEED - Matt. 13:31,32 - small to begin with, but growing greatly, even into a tree, until it becomes ready for a lodging place for the birds of the air (THE WICKED ONE) when Satan is released from the Abyss at the end of the thousand years.

(4) Zech. 5:5-11 - How prophets and righteous men must have desired to understand the mystery of Zechariah's vision of the woman sitting in the ephah - which is then sealed up with lead - yet afterward going into the land of Shinar where a house is built for the ephah.

Now Christ reveals this secret by stating that in the kingdom there will be a woman (the woman is Babylon) secretly hiding LEAVEN (corruption) IN THE MEAL until three measures become leavened. Matt. 13:33

It will be the same old Woman Babylon whom the ten kings (under the Antichrist in the middle of the WEEK) so hated and judged, and thus sealed up with lead (symbol of man's judgment) in an ephah (symbol of commerce). Rev. 17:12-18

In the Millennium this ephah (with the woman hidden inside) will appear. The woman is NOT riding any Beast, as in the Tribulation Week, but is sealed in a house in the land of Shinar, the old site of the city of Babylon. Rev. 18:1-7; Isa. 47

Outwardly, the city of Babylon will gradually grow as simply ONE of the great commercial centers of that prosperous Millennial time. TYRE also will be there in the kingdom as another great center of trade (Psa. 45:12) and Judah and the Land of Israel will trade in her markets. Ezek. 27:17

The Lord's people (true kingdom saints) also seem to trade in the city of Babylon. But at the end of the Millennium, Satan is loosed out of his prison, and goes to the great city Babylon to make it his headquarters. He then arouses his great company of Nations to march against Jerusalem the second time. Babylon the Great becomes filled with iniquity and becomes the habitation of demons and the hold of every foul spirit and a cage of every unclean and hateful bird. Rev. 18:2 (See the parable of The Mustard Seed.)

Then the Lord, before pouring out His final judgment upon her, calls His people out. (Rev. 18:4) Note that it is the Lord God Himself who judges the City Babylon at the close of the Millennium (Rev. 18 8) and not the ten kings who kill her and eat her flesh before the Millennium (Rev 17:16).

This time, in tead of hating this (OMMERCIAL FORM of Babylon (this woman hidden in e ephah in its house in the land of Shinar) as the ten kings hated the RELIGIOUS FORM of Babylon when she rode the Beast in Tribulation Times, they shall bewail her, and lament for her, when they shall see the smoke of her burning. Rev 18 9

During the Millennium, when he Lord once more has a city, the Holy Jerusalem, the counterfeit, Babylon will also take he orm f a city. (Rev. 18) Yet, hidden within the ephah (corn rcialism), will be the same old woman that the kings thought they had destroyed with their "lead" judgment

(5) If the Millennial k ngdom is to end in so great a rebellion, why bother bout having such a kingdom at all? Why such a worthless feld?

"Let me tell you snother secret," answers the Lord There is HIDDEN TREASURE IN THIS FIELD - Matt 13:44. "I have such j y over it that I have sold all I have to buy the field that I may have this treasure, even Israel (Seed of Abraham, chosen Nation)."

(6) "Yes, and more than that, I have found a pearl the saved Gentiles of the Mi lennial times. (Matt. 13:45,46) It is a goodly pea l and worth a great price to me. (Zeph. 3:17, Isa. 11:10) have sold all that I have to buy that pearl.'

(7) Then He tells the final secret - "There will be a

final rebellion of the nations However, ALL ISRAEL shall be saved in the Millennial Kingdom. (Rom. 11:26) They shall be the seed of the blessed of the Lord, and their offspring with them, and never again shall they depart from the Lord their God " (Isa. 65:23)

But the Gentiles, THE FISH FROM THE GREAT SEA (Matt. 13.47-50), when that net is pulled in at the end of the Millennial age, will contain bad fish as well as good fish, wicked as well as just. This shows that there will be a rebel ion at the end of the Millennium, not of Israel, but of the nations (Gentiles) which are in the four quarters of the earth, Gog and Magog. Rev. 20:8.

#### SUMMATION

Thus we have in these seven parables a complete unfolding of the secrets or mysteries of that Millennial Kingdom, which until then had been kept secret, unuttered, even to prophets and righteous men, much as they had desired to know them. How blessed then those that see and hear them!

Such scribes, thus instructed unto the Kingdom of Heaven, are like AN HOUSEHOLDER which bringeth forth out of his treasure THINGS NEW (the mysteries revealed by the Lord) as well as THINGS OLD (the things told by the Old Testament prophets). Only such scribes have the perfect understanding of the Millennial Kingdom that the Lord des res His people to have

For this very purpose He lighted this candle, and set it on a candlestick, for there was nothing hid (as in Old Testament times) which shall not be manifested, as the Lord had just manifested them in these parables. Mark 4:22.

### **Bible Baptisms**

#### By Maurice Hammond

The word BAPTISM has as a basic meaning "to become identified with." The original root, BAPTO, means to dip or to stain with dye, i.e., a material becomes permanently identified with the dye by taking on its color or character. The word BAPTISM does not mean immersion, although an immersion could be a baptism. An object could be immersed without being baptized, and it could be baptized without being immersed.

# **Apostasy**

There are three similar terms often confused with one another: Heresy, Backsliding, and Apostasy. We shall define each one:

**HERESY** - refers to a belief which is held in variance with standards or accepted features of doctrine. "Heretic" does not imply having embraced doctrine from which one has finally departed. That which is branded as heretical may have been an unaltered conviction or contention.

The criterion for judging "heresy" is the Word of God, but inasmuch as man's interpretation of what the Word teaches varies widely, one church's "heretic" may be another's "true apostle."

**BACKSLIDING** - is retreating gradually, voluntarily, or insensibly from the knowledge, faith, love, and profession of God, after having once entered into a covenant relationship with Him.

As a Biblical term it is used only of the nation Israel. (13 times in Jer. - 3 times in Hosea - once in Isa.) It is therefore a national sin, which God will forgive and heal for the nation, but not for the individual. In the "tribulation," the "latter days," individual Jews will believe and then be martyred for their faith. But these are not the individuals who "backslid" in the O.T. When the nation is called upon to repent and return to the Lord, (2 Chron. 7:14 and Jer. 3:12,22) it will be an altogether different generation of living Jews and not resurrected backsliders.

**APOSTASY** - is a "falling away from," a "withdrawal." It describes one who first embraced some creed or doctrine and afterwards turned away from it. A total departure from one's faith or religion, abandonment of creed and renunciation of religious obligations.

Either the individual or a group, (i.e., a church, denomination, nation, or organization) or both, may apostatize. It is therefore possible that a pure individual may be found within an apostate group, or a group which is not itself apostate may have apostate individuals as members.

#### EXAMPLES OF APOSTASY:

(1) FALLEN ANGELS - Jude 6; 1 Pet. 3:19,20.

(2) SATAN - John 8:44 - "he abode not in the truth."

Isa.14:13-14; Ezek. 28:15 - "Iniquity was found in him." Note that there is NO REMEDY for either Satan or his angels who withdrew from God. (Matt. 25:41) They shall spend eternity in the Lake of Fire!

(3) ADAM - Gen. 2:16,17 - He became an apostate by his one sin. There was NO REMEDY provided for him, no way of restoration to blessing with God, either in time or eternity. The following are some proofs:

a. The "Coat of skins" was applied to Adam's naked BODY, not to either his soul or spirit.

b. No mention is made of blood in this so-called "atoning work" of God. c. If God intended to show Adam that it was "by the shedding of blood" that there is remission of sins, he never got the message, because we have no record that he ever offered a sacrifice on his own by faith.

d. Adam is not mentioned in the "faith chapter," Heb.11, where God starts with Abel - and mentions his GIFTS (plural). Abel offered repeatedly upon God's altar.

e. In Gen. 6 God says He will not always strive with man (Adam), "for that he also is flesh; yet his days shall be an hundred and twenty years." Up to 120 years before his death, Adam was still an enemy of God!

f. "In Adam all die" (1 Cor. 15:22) - he is the head of all unregenerate men who finally inhabit the Lake of Fire.

(4) **ESAU** - "found no place of repentance, though he sought it carefully with tears." He could never recoup his birthright - it was lost to him for time and eternity.

(5) THE NATION ISRAEL - Backsliding with some degree of restoration was the constant experience of the nation, which stood on covensnt ground and was covered by the blood of the atonement (which was for the "nation" as a whole, and not for the individual members who had to daily bring their own sacrifices for sins). In every case, the individual Israelites who apostatized always died before the Lord. Jude 5 - In the apostasy at Kadish-Barea, not one of the apostates entered into the Land.

Israel is now in her last apostasy, there will never be another after she is restored from the present separation from Covenant blessings. (Deut. 28:15-68; 30:1-8; Isa. 1:4-6; 5:5-7) Note Isaiah 1:4 - (Outline below)

WHAT ISRAEL IS (State of BEING)

a. A SINFUL NATION - To miss the mark, falling short in act or thought, word, or deed, not a condition.

b. A PEOPLE LADEN WITH INIQUITY - heavily burdened with perverseness (bent or crooked).

c. A SEED OF EVILDOERS

d. CHILDREN THAT ARE CORRUPTERS

WHAT ISRAEL HAD DONE (State of DOING)

a. "They have forsaken the Lord" (Jehovah Himself) Apostasy in Disposition.

b. "They have provoked (despised, blasphemed) the Holy One of Israel unto anger."

Apostasy in Words.

c. "They are gone away backward"

Apostasy in Act.

Note - There was NO REMEDY for the individual apostate of the Nation. The blasphemy against the Holy Spirit is never forgiven! (Mk. 3:29; Isa. 63:10; Matt. 12:31; Acts 5:3)

(6) CHRISTENDOM - The "Christian Church" which was pure in its beginning, (under Paul and the apostles) has turned away from God and the Word as seen in the early "sects" and "cults," and with Constantine and the church of Rome, we see the extent of apostasy to which "Christendom" can go.

Through the centuries God has raised up REFORMERS. But these have never reformed the "Church" or denomination as a whole, but only became the rallying point for INDIVIDUAL BELIEVERS, who then united to form new denominations. These groups all in turn apostatized never to be revived, or brought back, but only to be superceeded by yet newer groups, churches, and denominations, all of which in their turn apostatized.

In the "last days" all of these apostate groups will unite ecumenically into the one great world church which will enthrone the antichrist. (Rev. 13:11-18)

There is NO REMEDY for the apostate church!

(7) INDIVIDUAL APOSTATES - When we get to the dispensation of "Grace" wherein the believers are "sealed unto the day of redemption." by the Holy Spirit, there is no possibility that an apostate will lose his salvation, but he will lose his rewards. In any case, it is ONLY a believer, one who has stood before God in Truth and Light, who can apostatize. An unbeliever has nothing to turn or withdraw from. He is merely "dead in trespasses and sins" (Eph. 2:1). In every other period but the age of Grace, the apostate lost both his blessings and/or life in time and his soul for all eternity. But, as we shall see below, the one who is a member of the Mystical Body of Christ will retain his position in etemity, but upon apostatizing loses his spiritual blessings in time and his rewards in eternity. Examples four through ten below envolve this dispensation of Grace.

1) Luke 17:32 - "Remember Lot's wife." She was "saved" from Sodom, but lost her life when she "looked back," apostatized. No remedy for her.

2) Luke 9:62 - "No man, having put his hand to the plough, and looking back, is fit for the kingdom of God."

3) John 6:66-71 - "From that time many of his disciples (and Judas) went back, and walked no more with him."

- 4) 1 Tim. 1:19 Hymanaeus and Alexander having put away THE FAITH have made shipwreck and I have delivered to Satan
- 5) 1 Tim. 4:1 "In the latter times SOME SHALL depart from THE FAITH giving heed to doctrines of demons and seducing spirits."
- 6) 2 Tim. 4:3,4 "And they shall turn away their ears from the TRUTH, and shall be turned unto FABLES."
- 7) Heb. 3:12-13 some "partakers of Christ" in departing from the Living God are hardened (irreparably) through the deceitfulness of SIN

8) Heb. 6:4-6 - "For it is IMPOSSIBLE for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted of the heavenly gift. and were made partakers of the Holy Ghost, and have tasted the good word of God. and the powers of the world to come. IF THEY SHALL FALL AWAY, TO RENEW them again unto repentance:..." This is speaking of believers who are saved, and not unbelievers who almost go' saved.

It states that REPENTANCE is IMPOSSIBLE (in this life), not that the soul is lost in hell." Such apostates "put Him to an open shame" and God will not permit such an one to make a mockery of Christ by repeatedly repenting and "coming back to God" after apostatizing. All spiritual power and blessing is lost in this life, though there may be a "form of godliness," and all "rewards" are lost for eternity. Instead of "redeeming the time" and "laying up treasures in heaven," the apostate is merely "spending the time" until he is called into judgment and his works burned, "but he himself shall be saved; yet so as by fire." (1 Cor. 3:9-15)

9) Heb. 10:23-31 - "For if we sin wilfully after that we have received the knowledge of the truth, there remaineth no more sacrifice for sins, but a certain fearful looking for of judgment and fiery indignation, which shall devour the adversaries." This passage is refering to believers (we) who's works are to be "tried by fire," the same fire which "shall devour the adversaries," (themselves, i.e. Satan and his followers) but which will destroy only the WORKS of the believer. The unbeliever himself is burned in the fire of God's judgment, whereas only the works of the believer are burned up. A terrifying thing none the less as Paul comments, in speaking of the judgment seat of Christ (for believers), "knowing therefore the terror of the Lord, we persuade men."

10) 2 Thess. 2:1-3 - The coming of our Lord Jesus Christ, and our gathering together unto Him, (at the Rapture, 1 Thess. 4:13-18) will be preceeded by the "great apostasy," the "falling away," which in turn will preceed and prepare the way for the revealing of the "man of sin," the Antichrist.

#### CONCLUSIONS

**AN INFIDEL (UNBELIEVER)** - may be overcome by a revelation of the Truth, and believe.

A HERETIC - may hold some error and be subject to correction in love. One may embrace some "heretical" doctrine or teaching and yet not apostatize.

A BACKSLIDER - Biblically refers only to the nation Israel. However, as the term is applied, it may refer to one who, though conceivably still "looking to the Lord" and not having turned away from Him unto Satan, has cooled off or "slidden back" from a former spiritual condition. Or one who has failed to "go on with the Lord." Presumably he could be restored at the great price which God exacted of the individual Jew in Israel - DEATH. In this dispensation of Grace however, it would mean "death to self" (Rom. 6:6,11; 2 Tim. 2:21) and "total commitment to Christ." (Rom. 6:13; 12:1,2) He must return to the point from which he departed, ( ) retracing with enfeebled steps the road down which he has slidden. Chastening, tribulation, and repentence will be his lot. (Heb. 12:5-17)

**BUT AN APOSTATE** - is one who once stood: "In Christ, in the Way, the Truth, the Light, the Faith, the Living God, sound doctrine, etc." and has turned away. One who apostatizes is said to have turned unto: "Satan, the doctrine of demons, fables, sin, the error of Satan, other gods, etc.," and there is no hope that he will ever be restored!
